Mathematics (for BME) Exam Information

The exams take place in

Tuesday, 21st March 2016.

The exam time will be given to the students individually.

Students have to bring their **student ID card ("BlueCard")** to the exams. Each student will be tested **individually** in an **oral exam** of **ca. 20-25 minutes**. The exams consist of a **conversation** about topics taken from the **lecture notes**. Also, students will have to demonstrate their ability to apply the theory to examples similar to those discussed in the lectures or practised in the **exercise classes**. A pen and sheets of paper (e.g. to demonstrate a calculation) will be provided. The exams are held in **English**.

Advice:

- Learn and understand the lecture notes.
- You will have to talk about mathematics (this includes stating definitions, calculation methods, arguments and theorems as well as explaining them). Therefore it is highly recommended to practise talking about mathematics with your fellow students.
- Take a look at the problem sheets and make sure you are able to perform important tasks/calculations like the ones we have practised there.

- There won't be enough time to talk about all topics. However, you don't know in advance what you will be asked about. So make sure not to leave out anything when learning.
- Don't worry if you don't know the answer to some questions at once. The exam is held as a dialogue. We will try and find the answer to more difficult questions together.
